

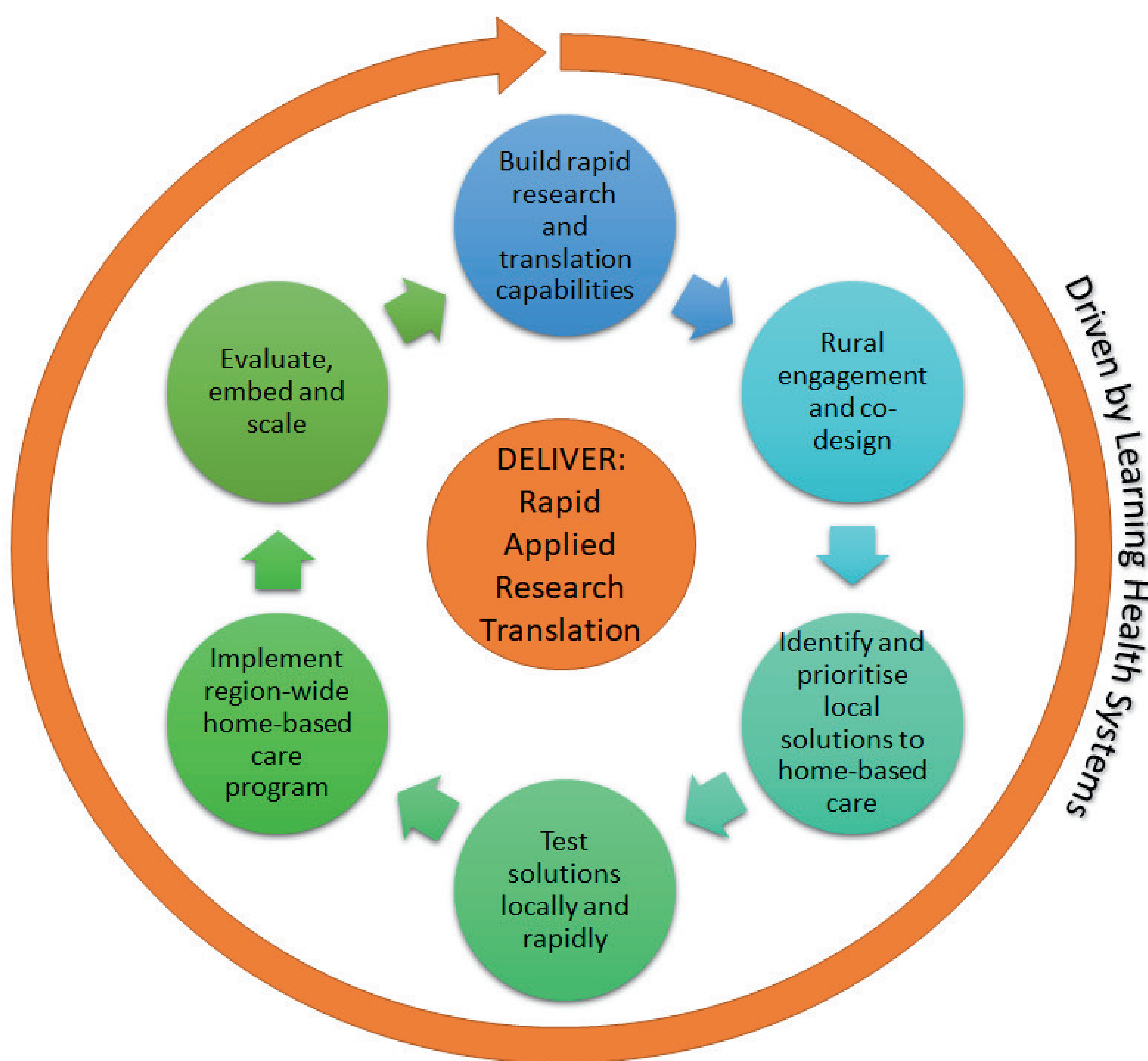


Research for better healthcare DELIVER closer to home

What is DELIVER?

DELIVER is a 5 year Commonwealth funded research program to invest in building collaborations between health services and academic institutions. DELIVER's aims are **improving home-based healthcare for older people** and **growing research and translation skills** in health services in western Victoria.

DELIVER brings together, for the first time, healthcare consumers, regional and rural health services, peak bodies, universities and primary healthcare providers across western Victoria to achieve better healthcare closer to home.



The DELIVER Research Project:

- Explores what the people and healthcare providers of western Victoria need most in terms of home-based healthcare services and identifies research-informed solutions
- Co-designs and tests local solutions, so that home-based healthcare services will continue to grow and improve across the region and beyond
- Supports the growth of research translation capability and capacity in western Victoria, so that future research findings can quickly be translated to improvements in healthcare

Focus areas identified from consultation with stakeholders:

Optimising uptake and reach of home-based healthcare

Optimising use / integration of digital tools to meet more care needs through home-based healthcare

Understanding consumer experience of home-based healthcare

Evaluation of home-based healthcare programs
